 Bad words and values – these are words observed by uncivilized.

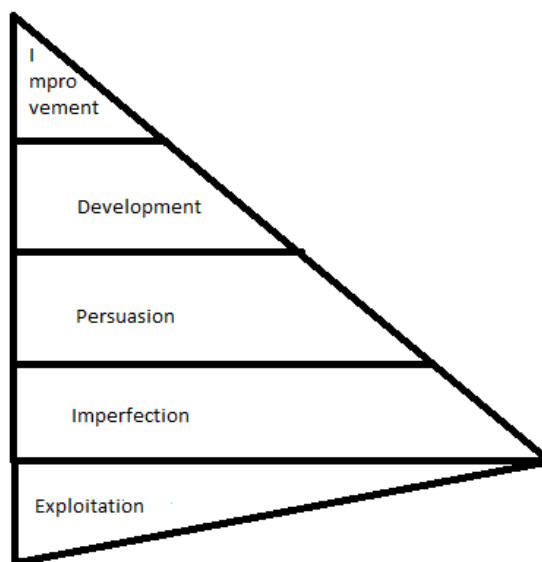


Fig-1: Hierarchy of Words
